All applicants are required to submit a **\$30 application** charge, official transcripts from all college/universities attended, study statement and two academic references. Programs that are not taught in English will require the SUNY foreign language proficiency form as well.

OVERSEAS SEMESTER STUDY PROGRAMS

Amsterdam

HES School of Economics & Management, Amsterdam
<http://www.international.hva.nl/>

- Semester exchange.
- Courses in business and economics. All courses taught in English.
- Junior and senior level business/economics students who have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale and have taken sufficient business or economics courses to enroll in third year subjects.
- Students reside in apartments.

Australia

Semester or academic year exchange/study abroad with four Australian universities: Preference given to juniors and seniors and those with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better (on 4.0 scale).

Central Queensland University, Rockhampton

- Exchange only.
- Courses offered in applied science arts, business, education, engineering, health science and performing arts.
- Students reside in a dormitory community.

University of Newcastle, Newcastle
<http://www.newcastle.edu.au/>

- Exchange and study abroad.
- Courses offered in, architecture, building and design, arts and social science, business, economics, education, engineering, law, health sciences, music, science and mathematics.
- Students reside in apartments.

- Exchange and study abroad.
- Courses offered in applied science, art, design, fashion, communication, biomedical and health sciences, business, constructed environment, education, engineering and nursing.
- Students reside in off-campus dormitory style housing or apartments.

OVERSEAS SEMESTER STUDY PROGRAMS

Australia Cont'd

University of South Australia, Adelaide

- Exchange and study abroad.
- Courses offered in Aboriginal and Islander studies, art, architecture and design, business and management, education, engineering and the environment, health and biomedical sciences, humanities and social science, information technology and nursing.
- Students reside in off-campus dormitory style housing or apartments.

Italy

Siena, Italy: Semester or academic year study abroad program

- Can fulfill general education requirements for arts, humanities, Western civilization and foreign language requirements. Curriculum includes Italian language and culture, studio art, art history, and hospitality and tourism.
- Classes taught in English, except for Italian language courses.
- Students live with Italian families; program includes various excursions.
- Requires a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 (on 4.0 scale), one semester of college-level Italian or equivalent is strongly recommended.

University of Siena

- Semester exchange.
- Requires a minimum of two years of college-level Italian, submission of writing sample in Italian (term paper or extended essay submitted for a class) and a portion of the entrance interview conducted in Italian.
- Direct enrollment in university classes.
- Students live in university residence halls.

England

Manchester Metropolitan University (MMU), Manchester <http://www.mmu.ac.uk/study/>

- Fall or spring semester exchange and study abroad.
- Open to sophomores, juniors and seniors in a wide range of majors. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better (on 4.0 scale).
- Students reside in on campus dormitory housing or in student apartments in the community.

INTERSESSION OVERSEAS STUDY PROGRAMS

Beijing, China

Chinese Culture and Business Practices
Central University of Finance and Economics

- Sophomores, juniors and seniors are eligible to apply; must be enrolled at Buffalo State and in good academic standing.
- Two week, January intercession program led by a faculty member; 3 credits: upper level business elective or marketing concentration course; taught in English.

Summer Programs

Beijing, China

Chinese Language & Culture Program

Co— Sponsored by University at Buffalo & Buffalo State

- 8 credit hour program, participants required to sign a language pledge promising to speak only Chinese.
- Requires a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 (on 4.0 scale) and successful completion of one semester of college-level Chinese or equivalent.

Puerto Rico

- Must be enrolled at Buffalo State and in good academic standing. Sophomores, juniors and seniors are eligible to apply.
- Three week, 6 credit hour program, no Spanish required.
- Requires participation in workshops during the preceding semester
- Great for education majors and anyone else who will be working in a culturally diverse setting.

Salamanca, Spain

- Spanish language and culture program designed for intermediate and advanced level undergraduate and graduate students.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.67 or better (on 4.0 scale); Spanish 101-102 or equivalent required.
- Students reside with a host family or in a residence hall.

Trois-Pistoles, Quebec

- French Immersion program; three week 3 credit hour or five week 6 credit hour options.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on 4.0 scale); French 101 or the equivalent required; participants required to sign a language pledge, promising to speak only French.
- Students reside with a host family.
